Tonight we will tour Italy with three fun, off the beaten path wines from Phil's portfolio. We will start with a crisp Alpine white from Alto Adige. Next, we will pour a delicious nebbiolo-based blend from Boca in Alto Piemonte, from iconic producer Le Piane. Finally, we will head south to Sicily to the teeny-tiny appellation of Faro. The great and only producer of consequence here is Palari. We will pour the delicious "Rosso del Soprano" - a Nerello Mascalese that is utterly mediterranean with sturdy structure that demands food. This will be a fun tour of Italy with the jolly Phil Laramore.
